The lawyer you speak with will provide you with free, confidential legal advice in order to help avoid or reduce the probability of a claim or complaint. Each telephone consultation is limited to 30 minutes per inquiry. The lawyer may consider it appropriate to review the issues and jurisprudence, and then call you back. The value of the advice given will rely on the accuracy and completeness of the information you provide. In some cases, you may be asked to contact BMS directly, as your issue may have already triggered coverage under your policy, in which case, legal counsel may be appointed to act on your behalf.
